Any Traditional College (TRAD) student, entering or returning, who would like to reside off-campus must complete this application by the stated deadline for the semester for which s/he is requesting. All forms must be filled out completely, reviewed by Financial Aid and returned to the Director of Residence Life (007 Lenfest Commons).

APPLICATION GUIDELINES *(Please read carefully)*

ALL students in the Traditional College (TRAD) are expected to live on campus, with exceptions as follows:

- Commuters living with parents or adult relatives within a 50 mile driving distance from campus
- Students 21 years of age or older and/or have senior standing as defined by the College Registrar
- Married students or students with dependents in their care
- Students participating in approved academic experiences such as student teaching, guest semesters, semesters abroad, U.N. semesters, etc.
- Students under 21 with junior status verified by the College Registrar, including students transferring in from other institutions, may apply for an exemption to the housing requirement. Highest consideration will be given to those with a GPA of 2.5 or higher and a clear conduct history. Applications will be reviewed by the Director of Residential Life and Dean of Students. Application does not guarantee approval.

Permission to live off campus for reasons other than those falling within the policy guidelines will be granted due to extreme or extraordinary circumstances only. Students who seek exemption should submit a petition describing the circumstances that justify an exemption along with this completed form. Exemption requests must still be reviewed by Financial Aid and submitted to the Director of Residence Life by stated deadlines but approval determination will rest with the Dean of Students and the Faculty Committee on Student Affairs.

All petitions for off campus housing need to be submitted to the Director of Residence Life no later than April 1st for the coming fall semester and November 15th for the coming spring semester. Requests from new entering students to live off campus must be received by the Director of Residence Life no later than 30 days prior to the start of the semester in which they are entering. Please note: applications received after the deadline may be denied outright or may be deferred for consideration until the following semester. Applicants who miss the deadline should consult with the Residence Life Director.
